D. Tax Exemption Status. DoDEA is an activity of the Federal Government. As such, state agencies are precluded from taxing them by reason of the Supreme Court decision in *McCullough v. Maryland*, 17 US 316 (1817). In addition, the various states have codified this immunity by appropriate statutes. DoDEA Federal Tax Identification Number: 53-0207336.

E. Contract Type and Duration. Contract award type shall be a Firm-Fixed Price Contract. The period of performance shall be 12 months from date of award.

STATEMENT OF WORK

1.0 INTRODUCTION

The Department of Defense Education Activity (DoDEA) requires booklets that provide middle and high school students and parents with a clear understanding of the purpose and value of DoDEA's PTS Career Clusters and Pathways.

2.0 BACKGROUND

DoDEA is an activity of the U.S. Department of Defense. It operates approximately 223 schools in 18 districts located in 14 foreign countries, seven states, Guam and Puerto Rico. All schools within DoDEA are fully accredited by U.S. accreditation agencies. Approximately 8,800 teachers serve DoDEA's 103,000 students. The DoDEA school system offers a typical American education and uses materials and equipment comparable to stateside schools.

DoDEA has adopted 11 of the Department of Education's (DOE) 16 nationally recognized Career Clusters and 22 associated pathways. Career Clusters represent major groupings of similar occupations and industries within the U.S. job market (e.g., business, information technology, manufacturing, health, human services). Each Cluster provides students with the "big picture" in terms of career options and an understanding the broad industry. Within each of the career clusters are various Career Pathways which represent a variety of occupational fields or jobs associated with the career cluster. Each DoDEA high school offers only those Clusters and Pathways that can be supported by the local school curriculum offerings.

3.0 SCOPE

The contractor shall research and develop the content with respect to the adopted DOE Clusters and Pathways to include: descriptions of DoDEA's Clusters and Pathways, appropriate curriculum maps, related careers and employment outlook (with pay) for occupations related to pathways, relevant and contemporary information resources. All developed materials must be appropriate for grades 7-12 students and their parents.

4.0 REQUIREMENT

4.1 Content research and development

4.1.1 The contractor shall research DoDEA's adoption of the Clusters and Pathways and research national work done with Clusters and Pathways. The contractor shall research national employment trends for occupations related to DoDEA's adopted Clusters and Pathways; for each pathway this includes descriptions and employment statistics for the top 10 fastest-growing jobs and associated training requirements (both secondary and post secondary).

4.1.2 The contractor shall develop maps, charts, recommended high school curricula, job success stories, that explain and inform students and their parents about DoDEA's Clusters and Pathways and the relationship and importance of the C&P to students' future careers and high school education.

4.2 Description of DoDEA's Clusters and Pathways

4.2.1 The contractor shall describe each adopted Cluster and Pathway to include DoDEA courses.

4.2.2 This shall include DoDEA's requirements for the student to receive a transcript endorsement for any given pathway.

4.3 Career and employment outlook

4.3.1 The contractor shall include the fastest-growing and highest-paying career choices associated with each pathway.

4.3.2 The contractor shall include the training requirements for success in each of the career choice.

4.3.3 The contractor shall include information on both formal and informal learning opportunities to enhance prospects of employment.

4.4 Information Resources. The contractor shall include a wide variety of contemporary and relevant resources for the students and parents to use in researching careers.

4.5 Printed Materials. The contractor shall:

4.5.1 Ensure printed materials are no more than 32 pages, use 4-color printing, 80 pound body stock and 100 pound cover stock and incorporate original or stock photography.

4.5.2 Provide all copyrights to the text and it will be owned by DoDEA.

4.5.3 The Contractor shall develop a draft DoDEA Pathways Booklet and deliver it to the Government for review.

4.5.4 The Contractor shall provide 3 copies of the final version of the proposed DoDEA Pathways Booklet to DoDEA for final approval before production.

4.5.5 The Contractor shall provide 45,000 DoDEA Pathways Booklets to DoDEA per the attached ship to address and quantities sheet.

4.6 Shipping. The contractor shall distribute materials directly to each delivery address (See Attachment, "Shipping Addresses") to the attention of the Supply Clerk/Principal utilizing receipted US Postal Service via APO/AE.

5.0 DELIVERABLES

5.1 Draft DoDEA Pathways Booklet for review due to DoDEA (30 days after contract award).

5.2 Edited and reviewed draft of DoDEA Pathways Booklet due back to the contractor (7 days after receipt).

5.3 Three (3) copies of the final draft version of the proposed DoDEA Pathways Booklet to DoDEA (7 days after receipt of reviewed draft).

5.4 Final Government approved DoDEA Pathways Booklet to contractor (7 days after receipt of final draft version).

5.5 Provide 45,000 copies of final approved DoDEA Pathways Booklet to designated addresses (60 days after receipt of approved final draft).

SECTION III

CONTRACT CLAUSES

FAR 52.212-4 CONTRACT TERMS AND CONDITIONS-COMMERCIAL ITEMS (OCT 2003)

- (a) *Inspection/Acceptance.* The Contractor shall only tender for acceptance those items that conform to the requirements of this contract. The Government reserves the right to inspect or test any supplies or services that have been tendered for acceptance. The Government may require repair or replacement of nonconforming supplies or reperformance of nonconforming services at no increase in contract price. The Government must exercise its post-acceptance rights-
- (1) Within a reasonable time after the defect was discovered or should have been discovered; and
 - (2) Before any substantial change occurs in the condition of the item, unless the change is due to the defect in the item.
- (b) *Assignment.* The Contractor or its assignee may assign its rights to receive payment due as a result of performance of this contract to a bank, trust company, or other financing institution, including any Federal lending agency in accordance with the Assignment of Claims Act (31 U.S.C. 3727). However, when a third party makes payment (*e.g.*, use of the Government wide commercial purchase card), the Contractor may not assign its rights to receive payment under this contract.
- (c) *Changes.* Changes in the terms and conditions of this contract may be made only by written agreement of the parties.
- (d) *Disputes.* This contract is subject to the Contract Disputes Act of 1978, as amended (41 U.S.C. 601-613). Failure of the parties to this contract to reach agreement on any request for equitable adjustment, claim, appeal or action arising under or relating to this contract shall be a dispute to be resolved in accordance with the clause at FAR 52.233-1, Disputes, which is incorporated herein by reference. The Contractor shall proceed diligently with performance of this contract, pending final resolution of any dispute arising under the contract.
- (e) *Definitions.* The clause at FAR 52.202-1, Definitions, is incorporated herein by reference.
- (f) *Excusable delays.* The Contractor shall be liable for default unless nonperformance is caused by an occurrence beyond the reasonable control of the Contractor and without its fault or negligence such as, acts of God or the public enemy, acts of the Government in either its sovereign or contractual capacity, fires, floods, epidemics, quarantine restrictions, strikes, unusually severe weather, and delays of common carriers. The Contractor shall notify the Contracting Officer in writing as soon as it is reasonably possible after the commencement of any excusable delay, setting forth the full particulars in connection therewith, shall remedy such occurrence with all reasonable dispatch, and shall promptly give written notice to the Contracting Officer of the cessation of such occurrence.
- (g) *Invoice.*
- (1) The Contractor shall submit an original invoice and three copies (or electronic invoice, if authorized) to the address designated in the contract to receive invoices. An invoice must include-
 - (i) Name and address of the Contractor;
 - (ii) Invoice date and number;
 - (iii) Contract number, contract line item number and, if applicable, the order number;
 - (iv) Description, quantity, unit of measure, unit price and extended price of the items delivered;
 - (v) Shipping number and date of shipment, including the bill of lading number and weight of shipment if shipped on Government bill of lading;
 - (vi) Terms of any discount for prompt payment offered;
 - (vii) Name and address of official to whom payment is to be sent;
 - (viii) Name, title, and phone number of person to notify in event of defective invoice; and

- (ix) Taxpayer Identification Number (TIN). The Contractor shall include its TIN on the invoice only if required elsewhere in this contract.
- (x) Electronic funds transfer (EFT) banking information.
- (A) The Contractor shall include EFT banking information on the invoice only if required elsewhere in this contract.
- (B) If EFT banking information is not required to be on the invoice, in order for the invoice to be a proper invoice, the Contractor shall have submitted correct EFT banking information in accordance with the applicable solicitation provision, contract clause (e.g., 52.232-33, Payment by Electronic Funds Transfer-Central Contractor Registration, or 52.232-34, Payment by Electronic Funds Transfer-Other Than Central Contractor Registration), or applicable agency procedures.
- (C) EFT banking information is not required if the Government waived the requirement to pay by EFT.
- (2) Invoices will be handled in accordance with the Prompt Payment Act (31 U.S.C. 3903) and Office of Management and Budget (OMB) prompt payment regulations at 5 CFR part 1315.
- (h) *Patent indemnity.* The Contractor shall indemnify the Government and its officers, employees and agents against liability, including costs, for actual or alleged direct or contributory infringement of, or inducement to infringe, any United States or foreign patent, trademark or copyright, arising out of the performance of this contract, provided the Contractor is reasonably notified of such claims and proceedings.
- (i) *Payment.-*
- (1) *Items accepted.* Payment shall be made for items accepted by the Government that have been delivered to the delivery destinations set forth in this contract.
- (2) *Prompt payment.* The Government will make payment in accordance with the Prompt Payment Act (31 U.S.C. 3903) and prompt payment regulations at 5 CFR part 1315.
- (3) *Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT).* If the Government makes payment by EFT, see 52.212-5(b) for the appropriate EFT clause.
- (4) *Discount.* In connection with any discount offered for early payment, time shall be computed from the date of the invoice. For the purpose of computing the discount earned, payment shall be considered to have been made on the date which appears on the payment check or the specified payment date if an electronic funds transfer payment is made.
- (5) *Overpayments.* If the Contractor becomes aware of a duplicate contract financing or invoice payment or that the Government has otherwise overpaid on a contract financing or invoice payment, the Contractor shall immediately notify the Contracting Officer and request instructions for disposition of the overpayment.
- (j) *Risk of loss.* Unless the contract specifically provides otherwise, risk of loss or damage to the supplies provided under this contract shall remain with the Contractor until, and shall pass to the Government upon:
- (1) Delivery of the supplies to a carrier, if transportation is f.o.b. origin; or
- (2) Delivery of the supplies to the Government at the destination specified in the contract, if transportation is f.o.b. destination.
- (k) *Taxes.* The contract price includes all applicable Federal, State, and local taxes and duties.
- (l) *Termination for the Government's convenience.* The Government reserves the right to terminate this contract, or any part hereof, for its sole convenience. In the event of such termination, the Contractor shall immediately stop all work hereunder and shall immediately cause any and all of its suppliers and subcontractors to cease work. Subject to the terms of this contract, the Contractor shall be paid a percentage of the contract price reflecting the percentage of the work performed prior to the notice of termination, plus reasonable charges the Contractor can demonstrate to the satisfaction of the Government using its standard record keeping system, have resulted from the termination. The Contractor shall not be required to comply with the cost accounting standards or contract cost principles for this purpose. This paragraph does not give the

Government any right to audit the Contractor's records. The Contractor shall not be paid for any work performed or costs incurred which reasonably could have been avoided.

(m) *Termination for cause.* The Government may terminate this contract, or any part hereof, for cause in the event of any default by the Contractor, or if the Contractor fails to comply with any contract terms and conditions, or fails to provide the Government, upon request, with adequate assurances of future performance. In the event of termination for cause, the Government shall not be liable to the Contractor for any amount for supplies or services not accepted, and the Contractor shall be liable to the Government for any and all rights and remedies provided by law. If it is determined that the Government improperly terminated this contract for default, such termination shall be deemed a termination for convenience.

(n) *Title.* Unless specified elsewhere in this contract, title to items furnished under this contract shall pass to the Government upon acceptance, regardless of when or where the Government takes physical possession.

(o) *Warranty.* The Contractor warrants and implies that the items delivered hereunder are merchantable and fit for use for the particular purpose described in this contract.

(p) *Limitation of liability.* Except as otherwise provided by an express warranty, the Contractor will not be liable to the Government for consequential damages resulting from any defect or deficiencies in accepted items.

(q) *Other compliances.* The Contractor shall comply with all applicable Federal, State and local laws, executive orders, rules and regulations applicable to its performance under this contract.

(r) *Compliance with laws unique to Government contracts.* The Contractor agrees to comply with 31 U.S.C. 1352 relating to limitations on the use of appropriated funds to influence certain Federal contracts; 18 U.S.C. 431 relating to officials not to benefit; 40 U.S.C. 327, *et seq.*, Contract Work Hours and Safety Standards Act; 41 U.S.C. 51-58, Anti-Kickback Act of 1986; 41 U.S.C. 265 and 10 U.S.C. 2409 relating to whistleblower protections; 49 U.S.C. 40118, Fly American; and 41 U.S.C. 423 relating to procurement integrity.

(s) *Order of precedence.* Any inconsistencies in this solicitation or contract shall be resolved by giving precedence in the following order:

- (1) The schedule of supplies/services.
- (2) The Assignments, Disputes, Payments, Invoice, Other Compliances, and Compliance with Laws Unique to Government Contracts paragraphs of this clause.
- (3) The clause at 52.212-5.
- (4) Addenda to this solicitation or contract, including any license agreements for computer software.
- (5) Solicitation provisions if this is a solicitation.
- (6) Other paragraphs of this clause.
- (7) The Standard Form 1449.
- (8) Other documents, exhibits, and attachments.
- (9) The specification.

(t) *Central Contractor Registration (CCR).*

(1) Unless exempted by an addendum to this contract, the Contractor is responsible during performance and through final payment of any contract for the accuracy and completeness of the data within the CCR database, and for any liability resulting from the Government's reliance on inaccurate or incomplete data. To remain registered in the CCR database after the initial registration, the Contractor is required to review and update on an annual basis from the date of initial registration or subsequent updates its information in the CCR database to ensure it is current, accurate and complete. Updating information in the CCR does not alter the terms and conditions of this contract and is not a substitute for a properly executed contractual document.

(2)(i) If a Contractor has legally changed its business name, "doing business as" name, or division name (whichever is shown on the contract), or has transferred the assets used in performing the contract, but has not completed the necessary requirements regarding novation and change-of-

name agreements in FAR Subpart 42.12, the Contractor shall provide the responsible Contracting Officer a minimum of one business day's written notification of its intention to (A) change the name in the CCR database; (B) comply with the requirements of Subpart 42.12; and (C) agree in writing to the timeline and procedures specified by the responsible Contracting Officer. The Contractor must provide with the notification sufficient documentation to support the legally changed name.

(ii) If the Contractor fails to comply with the requirements of paragraph (t)(2)(i) of this clause, or fails to perform the agreement at paragraph (t)(2)(i)(C) of this clause, and, in the absence of a properly executed novation or change-of-name agreement, the CCR information that shows the Contractor to be other than the Contractor indicated in the contract will be considered to be incorrect information within the meaning of the "Suspension of Payment" paragraph of the electronic funds transfer (EFT) clause of this contract.

(3) The Contractor shall not change the name or address for EFT payments or manual payments, as appropriate, in the CCR record to reflect an assignee for the purpose of assignment of claims (see Subpart 32.8, Assignment of Claims). Assignees shall be separately registered in the CCR database. Information provided to the Contractor's CCR record that indicates payments, including those made by EFT, to an ultimate recipient other than that Contractor will be considered to be incorrect information within the meaning of the "Suspension of payment" paragraph of the EFT clause of this contract.

1. ADDENDUM to FAR 52.212-4 CONTRACT TERMS AND CONDITIONS --

COMMERCIAL ITEMS (OCT 2003)

a. The following is added to paragraph (c) "Changes" after the last period:

“(The phrase, “terms and conditions” means any statement regarding the substantive rights of either or both parties.). Other changes (for example, a change in the paying office, appropriations data or Contracting Officer’s Representative) may be made unilaterally by written order signed by the Contracting Officer.”

b. The following clauses and clause references are incorporated at the end of FAR 52.212-4, after paragraph (t) "Central Contractor Registration (CCR)" as paragraph (u): "Other Clauses":

FAR 52.252-2 CLAUSES INCORPORATED BY REFERENCE (FEB 1998)
