1.0. BACKGROUND

1.1. The Department of Defense Education Activity (DoDEA) serves the educational needs of the dependents of military and civilian employees by providing PK-12 instruction to over 90,000 students. DoDEA's curriculum, resources, and student achievement scores on standardized assessments compare favorably to high-performing US public schools. DoDEA is divided into three administrative areas. DDESS (Domestic Dependent Elementary and Secondary Schools) covers seven states, Puerto Rico, and (for administrative purposes) Cuba. DoDDS (Department of Defense Dependent Schools) is divided into two areas: DoDDS-Europe and DoDDS-Pacific. The Standards for the DoDEA JK&S programs are guided by the National Standards in Foreign Language Education prepared by the American Council on the Teaching of Foreign Languages (ACTFL). Additionally, DoDEA requires that instructional technology materials for JK&S are congruent with the National Educational Technology Standards for Students (NETS*S), which can be found at the following URL: http://cnets.iste.org/students/s_stands.html

2.1.1 The DoDEA foreign language initiative defines a JK&S Heritage Speaker student as a language student who is raised in a home where a non-English language is spoken, who speaks or at a minimum understands the language, and who is to some degree bilingual in that language and in English.

2.2 Multiple awards may be made as a result of this solicitation. The contractor(s) shall submit target language specific curriculum materials listed in this section for one or more developmental level(s), including Heritage Speaker programs, for these languages. The contract may be awarded individually by developmental levels and/or for Heritage Speaker programs or one contractor may be awarded the contract for more than one of the developmental levels and/or relevant Heritage Speaker programs.

3.0. INSTRUCTIONAL MATERIALS REQUIREMENTS

3.1. The Contractor(s) shall provide published copyrighted instructional materials, software, technical support (if applicable) and professional development for the Contractor(s)' JK&S materials that are adopted by DoDEA. They shall consist of such materials as student textbooks, student workbooks, teacher editions, teacher resource materials, assessment materials, and digital courseware such as online, CD-ROM, downloadable material, audio-cassette tapes, or videos, DVDs, integral to the implementation of the curriculum.

3.2. All materials shall:

3.2.1. Be aligned to national standards and shall include learning strategies and age- and developmentally-appropriate activities and include recommended activities for a variety of instructional, ability, and multiage levels.

3.2.3. All materials shall have copyright dates no later than 2001 for print material and be consistent with material available to school systems in the United States.

3.2.4. All materials shall be suitable for use by teachers proficient in Japanese, Korean and/or Spanish.

3.2.5. All materials shall be free of racial, color, national origin, age, disabling conditions, sexual, religious, and ethnic bias, and shall present a balanced coverage of multi-cultural contributions, where appropriate.

3.3. The Contractor(s) shall supply student and teacher textbooks and resources that may include the following:

3.3.1. Student textbooks and related student materials/kits

3.3.2. Teacher editions, both printed and electronic/CD-ROM.

3.3.3. Teacher resources and packages that supplement the textbooks and may include posters, transparencies, and pictures on CD-ROM.

3.3.4. Instructional technology that may include audio-visual, DVD, online, or other electronic materials, all of which are compatible with DoDEA school-level technology (4.0 *Technical Requirements*).

3.3.5. Assessment materials that are aligned to the textbooks, such as quizzes, chapter tests, and summative examinations.

3.3.6. Authentic literature that provide lessons on the actual cultures (Japanese, Korean, and Hispanic).

3.4. The estimated quantity of instructional materials required during the Base Year and Option Years is shown below. It does not guarantee or confirm the actual order quantity.

3.5. *Replacement and Replenishment:* The estimates in Tables 1 (above) are for planning purposes only and do not represent a commitment on the part of the Government that such quantities will be ordered.

3.6. *Professional Development:*

3.6.1. The Contractor(s) shall provide up to three days of face-to-face initial Pre-Implementation and Implementation professional development for DoDEA JK&S teachers and area/district instructional systems specialists at a site specified by the Government during a fifteen (15) month Base Period.

3.6.2. In Option Years 1-3 and Option Period Four (9 months) if options are exercised, the Contractor(s) shall provide professional development that covers pre-implementation and implementation needs of DoDEA JK&S teachers and area/district instructional systems specialists. The Government will work with the Contractor(s) to design and facilitate the Option

Period trainings. After face-to-face professional development has been completed by the end of the Base Period, the professional development delivery model shall either be stand-alone presentational modules or website access trainings.

3.6.3. *Draft Professional Development Plan*: The Contractor(s) shall provide with the proposal a draft Professional Development Plan. The Plan shall contain the following elements:

- An outline, which cannot exceed ten pages (Times New Roman, 12 font, 1-inch margins, printed on one side of the page), that includes but is not necessarily limited to: training objectives, sample agenda, sequence of activities, best practices in JK&S teaching, practice in using all instructional technology and assessment components to inform instruction and support student achievement, resources, and bibliography.
- At least one sample training module and related materials
- A 1-2 page vitae showing the expertise of the trainer(s)
- The correlation of the materials to the *Standards for Foreign Language Learning in the 21st Century* (published by the American Council on the Teaching of Foreign Languages, copyright 1999).

3.6.3.1. *Post-Award Conference*: No later than fifteen (15) business days after the contract award, a two-day meeting at DoDEA HQ in Arlington, Virginia at which time the COR and other DoDEA staff will meet with the Contractor(s) to review the contract, coordinate details associated with the delivery of core instructional materials for each course in the quantities ordered for each school, discussion of the post-award professional development actions that include the final Professional Development Plan, performance tasks, travel, dry run, training, and schedules.

3.6.4. *Post-Award Professional Development Actions*: After the contract award, the following will occur: (1) the development of a final Professional Development Plan, (2) Correlations Document, (3) Classroom Observational Guide, (4) “Dry Run” of the Pre-Implementation Training prior to the actual training, and revisions to the Pre-Implementation Training based on the “Dry Run”.

3.6.4.1. *Final Professional Development Plan Components*: The final professional development plan shall be developed from the draft by the Contractor(s) in collaboration with the COR. This Final Plan has two major sections: Pre-Implementation and Implementation. Each section shall include training modules and materials, provided by the Contractor, using the elements below:

- Unit design, including lesson objectives and alignment to the DoDEA Foreign Language Standards and Proficiency Expectations, National Education Standards for Students NETS*S, and their relationship to key items in the DoDEA Quality Indicator Map (QIM). The DoDEA standards may be accessed at the following URL: http://www.dodea.edu/instruction/curriculum/DoDEA_Content_Stand.htm. The QIM may be accessed at www.dodea.edu/instruction/curriculum/QIMap/QIMapfinal.doc.
- Performance tasks. Tasks provide students opportunities to show what they know and what they are able to do in relation to the standards (section 3.6.4.1.3).

3.6.4.1.1 *Training Modules*: Modules shall provide (a) in-depth knowledge of the curriculum, instruction, and assessment relative to the JK&S curriculum and relative to children's learning needs and (b) follow-up training for area/district instructional systems specialists on the skills needed in using the curriculum materials. The modules shall directly support DoDEA's Foreign Language Standards, Proficiency Expectations, and the DoDEA QIM.

3.6.4.1.2. *Unit Design*: Using the Contractor's materials, DoDEA's Foreign Language Standards statements shall be translated into lesson objectives answering the following questions:

- What do I want students to know and be able to do?
- What knowledge/skills do students need to have prior to instruction, including consideration of their level of proficiency in the target language of instruction?
- How will I measure if the students have met the DoDEA Foreign Language Standards and Proficiency Expectations?
- What instructional techniques will assist all students to meet the DoDEA Foreign Language Standards and Proficiency Expectations?

The following list shows the key QIM items (section 3.6.4.1) that need to be referenced in the unit design:

- C-1. Standards provide the foundation for the design, content, and delivery of instruction
- C-2. The teacher possesses content knowledge, an understanding of its relation to standards, and a facility in adapting content to allow all students access to standards.
- C-4. Approved and appropriate materials correlated to standards are used for instructions
- I-2. Students are meaningfully engaged throughout the learning process.
- I-3 Students have multiple and varied opportunities to meet/exceed the standards.
- I-7. Technology is meaningfully integrated throughout instruction to support student achievement of the DoDEA foreign language content standards and DoDEA technology standards for students.
- E-2. Instructional time is maximized to support all students in meeting/exceeding the standards
- A-2. Assessment is used to measure and improve standards-based student performance.

3.6.4.1.3. *Performance Tasks*: The Contractor(s) shall:

- Design essential performance tasks, which are aligned to the DoDEA Foreign Language Standards, engage students, simulate a real-world context, inspire curiosity, and provoke critical and creative thinking.
- Provide task analysis that delineates precisely what a student should know and be able to do as prerequisites for achieving the concepts and skills of a performance task.
- Plan conceptual development of ideas utilizing adopted materials that will enable students to achieve the performance tasks.

- Incorporate multiple assessment strategies.

3.6.4.2. *Correlation Documents*: The Contractor(s) shall provide (a) correlation of course materials with the DoDEA Foreign Language Content Standards and Proficiency Expectations, which are informed by the aforementioned *Standards for Foreign Language Learning in the 21st Century* and (b) correlation of use of technology to the NETS*S standards.

3.6.4.3. *Classroom Observational Guide*: Develop a one-page Classroom Observational Guide (checklist) that observers, primarily administrators, should see when visiting classrooms. The Guide shall be aligned to the QIM and shall list key components of the program, research-based best teaching strategies, and the Contractor's materials.

3.6.4.4. *Dry Run and Revisions to the Pre-Implementation Training*: The Contractor(s), in coordination with the COR, shall present a dry run of the Pre-Implementation training at DoDEA HQ in Arlington, Virginia. The presenters should include the actual trainers that the Contractor(s) have chosen for the summer trainings (Section 3.6.5 and 3.6.6). This dry run and subsequent discussions are expected to last two days. The Contractor(s) shall make revisions to the modules and materials prior to the first Pre-Implementation training that takes place no later than December of 2007 (section 3.6.5).

3.6.5. *Pre-Implementation Training*: This training shall consist of up to three days of face-to-face training (prior to the actual use of instructional materials in the classroom) during the Base Period, at a location provided by the Government. DoDEA will provide for contractor travel and per diem in accordance with FAR (section 7.0). The Contractor(s) shall provide the facilitator(s) and all training materials to an audience of approximately 20-60 participants, depending on the target language group, consisting primarily of area/district instructional systems specialists and Foreign Language teachers. This training shall address the organization and content of adopted curriculum materials and the ways they should be used for maximum learning. It shall include any technology training necessary to fully implement the materials required in the curriculum, and any technology components shall be aligned with NETS*S.

3.6.6. *Implementation Training*: This training is expected to occur in the Base Period between November-December of 2007 at a site designated by the Government. The Implementation training shall mirror the earlier pre-implementation training of the Base Period (section 3.6.5) and will potentially include information as shown below. The Implementation training shall be up to three days of face-to-face training to an audience of approximately 20-60 participants, depending on target language group, consisting primarily of area/district instructional systems specialists and Foreign Language teachers. DoDEA will provide for contractor travel and per diem in accordance with FAR (section 7.0). This training shall address the organization and content of adopted curriculum materials and the ways they should be used for maximum learning. It shall include any technology training necessary to fully implement the materials

required in the curriculum, and any technology components will be aligned with NETS*S. The Contractor(s)' facilitators shall do this Implementation training no later than December of 2007.

3.6.7. Post-Implementation Actions: In the Option Periods, the Government may require the following services from the Contractor(s): Follow-Up Training Modules, Post-Implementation Training, and/or Consulting. If such services are required, the Government will negotiate separate delivery orders with the Contractor(s). All coordination for work at areas, districts, or schools shall be made through the COR. More specific information is shown below.

3.6.7.1. Follow-Up Training Modules: The Government may request follow-up modules that provide more intensive teacher assistance and instructional models. These modules shall demonstrate model lessons and best practices appropriate for the grade level. If a module is needed, it shall be developed in coordination with the COR and shall be determined after the exercise of each Option Period under this contract.

3.6.7.2. Post-Implementation Training: The Contractor(s) shall provide experienced facilitator(s) for training of area/district instructional systems specialists and teachers, which shall include training modules and tools for delivery such as outlines, scripts, agendas, online courses, transparencies, support materials, and videos for use during training. If training is needed, all agendas shall be developed and visitation schedules formulated in coordination with the COR and shall be determined after the exercise of each Option Period under this contract.

3.6.7.3. Consulting: The Contractor(s) shall be available for onsite consultations with area/district instructional systems specialists as needed. If an onsite consultation is needed, all agendas shall be developed and visitation schedules formulated on a school-by-school basis in coordination with the COR and shall be determined after the exercise of each Option Period under this contract.

4.0. TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS

4.1. If online courses or instructional software is required, DoDEA must confirm that it is compatible with DoDEA school-level technology. All software will undergo preliminary testing to ensure that it poses no security risk. DoDEA may choose to eliminate a vendor's materials from consideration subject to the results of this preliminary test for software compatibility.

4.2. *Software and Digital Content Requirements*: DoDEA requires use of online digital mode(s) and software in a stand-alone, network or online mode. All software should be Section 508 compliant.

4.3. The Contractor(s) shall deliver any online materials on a web-based platform and provide course or video in a medium that can be converted to streaming video that is accessible from a dialup connection and compatible with the hardware and operating system requirements listed below:

4.4. All technical support should be available to meet the needs of DoDEA’s educators who are located throughout the world. If online support is required, DoDEA will assign a person to serve as the primary point of contact (POC) for this initiative. Response time will be 24 hours, not to include weekends. The DoDEA POC will work directly with the Contractor(s) online technical support when problems arise. The Contractor shall submit to the DoDEA POC on a quarterly basis in the Base Year (and annually in the Option Years) the answers to FAQ based on the most commonly reported problems.

4.5. *Licenses, Software Maintenance and Upgrades*: Maintenance support shall be renewable for the four option periods. Maintenance is defined as automatic distribution of software upgrades and revisions that can be accomplished using a combination of these distribution methods—Internet, email, or CD-ROM/DVD media after the COR provides a delivery order with written instructions. Any licenses for online digital material(s) and software shall include compatibility with DoDEA school-level technology and Department of Defense (DoD) information technology requirements. Contractor(s) shall not contact schools directly prior to dissemination of software, but shall coordinate the dissemination of upgrades or revisions through the COR and will provide four copies or electronic distributions of the update and/or revision to the COR for testing by each Area IT Division prior to the COR issuing a delivery order for distribution of same upgrade or revision. The COR in collaboration with the IT Division will ensure that the upgrades or revisions are compatible with existing school-level technology prior to issuing a delivery order.

5.0 PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

5.1. It is anticipated that materials will be purchased for availability to DoDEA teachers in the summer of 2007 prior to the initial introduction of the program. The term of the contract shall be for a base period of fifteen (15) months from the date of contract award with Option Years 1-3 and Option Period Four totaling 9 months (if options are exercised). (See tables 3.4.)

5.2. *Instructional Materials*: The Contractor(s) shall provide for the delivery of student textbooks and supplementary materials, teacher editions and related resources, per the tables in 3.4. The Government will provide the breakdown of numbers and levels of consumables required at the time that a delivery order is issued.

5.2.1. The Contractor(s) shall deliver all JK&S materials to DoDEA secondary schools per the delivery orders and one set of materials to the COR and the three Area instructional systems specialists within fifteen days after receipt of a delivery order for schools in the US (initial delivery order only) and within 30 days after receipt of a delivery order for schools in Europe and the Pacific.

5.2.2. In Option Periods, materials shall be delivered within 30 days of receiving a delivery order.

5.3. The Contractor(s) shall make all materials available throughout the duration of the curriculum adoption period and assure that the copyright dates of these materials remain unchanged for the entire contract period.

6.0 PERFORMANCE AND DELIVERY SCHEDULE

6.1 The Contractor(s) shall furnish all services to be performed and all items to be delivered in accordance with the following delivery schedule:

D. TAX EXEMPTION STATUS

CLAUSES INCORPORATED BY FULL TEXT

52.212-5 CONTRACT TERMS AND CONDITIONS REQUIRED TO IMPLEMENT STATUTES OR
EXECUTIVE ORDERS--COMMERCIAL ITEMS (NOV 2006) (DEVIATION)

(a) Comptroller General Examination of Record. The Contractor agrees to comply with the provisions of this paragraph (a) if the contract was awarded using other than sealed bid, is in excess of the simplified acquisition threshold, and does not contain the clause at 52.215-2, Audit and Records-Negotiation.

(1) The Comptroller General of the United States, or an authorized representative of the Comptroller General, shall have access to the right to examine any of the Contractor's directly pertinent records involving transactions related to this contract.

(2) The Contractor shall make available at its offices at all reasonable times, the records, materials, and other evidence for examination, audit, or reproduction, until 3 years after final payment under this contract or for any shorter period specified in FAR Subpart 4.7, Contractor Records Retention, of the other clauses of this contract. If this contract is completely or partially terminated, the records relating to the work terminated shall be made available for 3 years after any resulting final termination settlement. Records relating to appeals under the disputes clause or to litigation or the settlement of claims arising under or relating to this contract shall be made available until such appeals, litigation, or claims are finally resolved.

(3) As used in this clause, records include books, documents, accounting procedures and practices, and other data, regardless of form. This does not require the Contractor to create or maintain any record that the Contractor does not maintain in the ordinary course of business or pursuant to a provision of law.

(b) Notwithstanding the requirements of any other clause in this contract, the Contractor is not required to flow down any FAR clause, other than those in paragraphs (i) through (vii) of this paragraph in a subcontract for commercial items. Unless otherwise indicated below, the extent of the flow down shall be as required by the clause--

(i) 52.219-8, Utilization of Small Business Concerns (MAY 2004) (15 U.S.C. 637(d)(2) and (3)), in all subcontracts that offer further subcontracting opportunities. If the subcontract (except subcontracts to small business concerns) exceeds \$500,000 (\$1,000,000 for construction of any public facility), the subcontractor must include 52.219-8 in lower tier subcontracts that offer subcontracting opportunities.

(a) Any supplies and services to be furnished under this contract shall be ordered by issuance of delivery orders or task orders by the individuals or activities designated in the Schedule. Such orders may be issued from contract award through 60 months.

(b) All delivery orders or task orders are subject to the terms and conditions of this contract. In the event of conflict between a delivery order or task order and this contract, the contract shall control.

(c) If mailed, a delivery order or task order is considered "issued" when the Government deposits the order in the mail. Orders may be issued orally, by facsimile, or by electronic commerce methods only if authorized in the Schedule.

52.216-19 ORDER LIMITATIONS. (OCT 1995)

There are no minimum or maximum order quantities under this contract. The Contractor shall honor all orders received unless an order (or orders) is returned to the ordering office within 5 calendar days after issuance, with written notice stating the Contractor's intent not to ship the item (or items) called for and the reasons. Upon receiving this notice, the Government may acquire the supplies or services from another source.

52.216-21 REQUIREMENTS (OCT 1995)

(a) This is a requirements contract for the supplies or services specified, and effective for the period stated, in the Schedule. The quantities of supplies or services specified in the Schedule are estimates only and are not purchased by this contract. Except as this contract may otherwise provide, if the Government's requirements do not result in orders in the quantities described as "estimated" or "maximum" in the Schedule, that fact shall not constitute the basis for an equitable price adjustment.

(b) Delivery or performance shall be made only as authorized by orders issued in accordance with the Ordering clause. Subject to any limitations in the Order Limitations clause or elsewhere in this contract, the Contractor shall furnish to the Government all supplies or services specified in the Schedule and called for by orders issued in accordance with the Ordering clause. The Government may issue orders requiring delivery to multiple destinations or performance at multiple locations.

(c) Except as this contract otherwise provides, the Government shall order from the Contractor all the supplies or services specified in the Schedule that are required to be purchased by the Government activity or activities specified in the Schedule.

(d) The Government is not required to purchase from the Contractor requirements in excess of any limit on total orders under this contract.

(e) If the Government urgently requires delivery of any quantity of an item before the earliest date that delivery may be specified under this contract, and if the Contractor will not accept an order providing for the accelerated delivery, the Government may acquire the urgently required goods or services from another source.

(f) Any order issued during the effective period of this contract and not completed within that period shall be completed by the Contractor within the time specified in the order. The contract shall govern the Contractor's and Government's rights and obligations with respect to that order to the same extent as if the order were completed during the contract's effective period; provided, that the Contractor shall not be required to make any deliveries under this contract after 60 months.

52.217-8 OPTION TO EXTEND SERVICES (NOV 1999)

The Government may require continued performance of any services within the limits and at the rates specified in the contract. These rates may be adjusted only as a result of revisions to prevailing labor rates provided by the Secretary of Labor. The option provision may be exercised more than once, but the total extension of performance hereunder shall not exceed 6 months. The Contracting Officer may exercise the option by written notice to the Contractor within 30 days.

52.217-9 OPTION TO EXTEND THE TERM OF THE CONTRACT (MAR 2000)

(a) The Government may extend the term of this contract by written notice to the Contractor within 30 days; provided that the Government gives the Contractor a preliminary written notice of its intent to extend at least 60 days before the contract expires. The preliminary notice does not commit the Government to an extension.

(b) If the Government exercises this option, the extended contract shall be considered to include this option clause.

(c) The total duration of this contract, including the exercise of any options under this clause, shall not exceed 60 months.
